This approval is valid for calendar years 2019 through 2023 only.

HAPAC-Federal and the American Hospital Association's PAC (AHAPAC) work closely together to identify and support candidates at the federal level. This form must be signed by the CEO, or his designee, in order for qualified contributions to be transferred to the AHAPAC.
